Second Grade

Line Examples: Zig Zag, Straight, Bumpy, Wavy, Broken, Curly







Step 1:

Write FULL NAME on back of base paper; NO NAME, NO FAME!

Step 2:

Fill base of paper with flat line examples (background)

Step 3:

Fold paper/ curl paper/ bend paper to create all different types of lines. Secure ends down with glue.

- Overlap and intertwine lines together!

Step 4:

Clean up area!

- Paper scraps in bucket
- Glue away in bucket
- All scraps off floor!
- Place paper on drying cart by windows!
