**Romero Britto:** Internationally renowned pop artist Romero Britto uses vibrant colors and bold patterns as a visual language of hope and happiness, reflecting his optimistic faith in the world around him.

**<u>Pop-Art</u>**: art based on modern popular culture and the mass media, especially as a critical or ironic comment on traditional fine art values.

**<u>Cubism</u>**: made of simple geometric shapes, interlocking planes, and, later, collage
