


Step 2 = 6 base colors

Step 3 = tertiary

Step 4 = tint

Step 5 = shade





Step 1: Write <u>name</u> on line!

Step 2:

Put <u>6 base colors</u> around circle in <u>outermost ring;</u> skipping a section each time (<u>primary</u> + <u>secondary</u> colors) RED ____ORANGE ___YELLOW ___ GREEN ___ BLUE ___ VIOLET

Step 3:

Mix two base colors on either side of blank area to create <u>tertiary</u> color (ex: red + orange = red-orange) (ex: yellow + green = yellow-green)

Step 4: The <u>middle ring</u>, mix <u>base color</u> + <u>white</u> to make a TINT

Step 5: Inner ring, mix base color + little black to make a SHADE

Step 6: Paint first initial from first name over color wheel.

Step 7: Place onto drying rack, clean up!

** Do not waste paint!!
Little paint goes a long way!
**Rinse brush + paper towel test before switching colors!
Colors should be clean when returned!

Step 6 = add first initial
