- 1. Write name on back of paper.
- 2. Hold paper long ways.. also called, Portrait!
- 3. Draw an **abstract portrait** using <u>shapes</u> for facial features.
- 4. Draw geometric and organic lines on paper in background. (Create a variety of *section sizes*, *shapes*, and *lines*.)

5. Paint each section a different color,

DO NOT MIX COLORS IN PAINT CONTAINERS ..

MIX ON PALATE PAPER

- Tint: COLOR + WHITE
- Shade: COLOR + little bit of BLACK
- 6. Outline lines with black glue.
- 7. Place onto drying rack + clean-up!

Abstract: has lines, shapes, and color
