## Picasso Inspired Portrait Cubism Painting <br> Third Grade

1. Write name on back of paper.
2. Hold paper long ways.. also called, Portrait!
3. Draw an abstract portrait using shapes for facial features.
4. Draw geometric and organic lines on paper in background.
(Create a variety of section sizes, shapes, and lines.)
5. Paint each section a different color, DO NOT MIX COLORS IN PAINT CONTAINERS.. MIX ON PALATE PAPER

- Tint: COLOR + WHITE
- Shade: COLOR + little bit of BLACK

6. Outline lines with black glue.
7. Place onto drying rack + clean-up!

Abstract: has lines, shapes, and color
Cubism: movement in art, made of simple geometric shapes, interlocking planes, and, later, collage.
