## **Monochromatic // Tints and Shades Geometric Painted Abstract Names**

## **Fourth Grade**

MONOCHROMATIC: variations in lightness and saturation of a single color

TINT: colors that are made lighter by adding white

SHADE: colors made by adding black

GEOMETRIC: using simple geometric forms such as circles and squares in design and decoration


ABSTRACT: denoting art characterized by geometric, formalized, or otherwise nonrepresentational



Step 1: Write <u>full name</u> on back of paper

Step 2:

\*\* LIGHTLY with Pencil;
Draw name large and
sloppy then outline name.



Step 3: Lightly use a ruler to draw lines - 8 lines total, drawn at angles (4 long side and 4 short side)

Step 4:
Choose main base
color that you will mix
into tints and shades
using black and white



Step 5: Start with <u>base color + white</u> to make various TINTS in one area separated by two lines \*\*focal point \*\* each divided area is a different tint



Step 6: Start with <u>base color + black</u> to make various shades in rest of area \*\* each divided area is a different shade



Step 7: Finish painting — check is it neat, creative,
