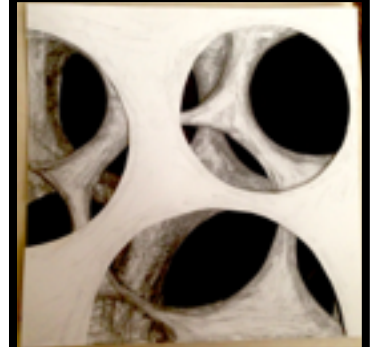
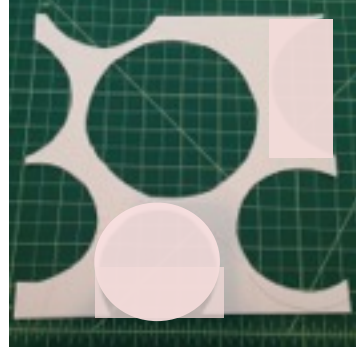

Cut-out 3D Layered Value Nets + Drawings

Value: the lightness or darkness of a color

Fifth Grade



Step 1:
Get 4 sheets of card stock 8x8inches and 1 sheet of black construction paper.

Step 2:
Glue ONE card stock to the black paper and put name onto card stock (this is your background with BLACK side facing up)

Step 3:
**** Do NOT let any corner get cut off when drawing!!! Need the corners for support when assembling project!**

- On ONE card stock paper draw **3 shapes** - small, medium, large (foreground - lightest)
- On ONE card stock paper draw **4 shapes** - 2 small, medium, large (middle ground - medium tones)
- On ONE card stock paper draw **5 shapes** - 3 small, medium, large (middle ground - darkest tones)

Step 4:
Cut out shapes; to get a middle cut out — bend paper lightly, snip, then cut from the center out to drawn line

Step 5:
Shade around shapes (3 shapes = lightest value, 4 shapes = medium value, 5 shapes = darkest shaded value)

Step 6:
Assemble project — darkest to lightest!
- Background, 5 shapes, 4 shapes, and 3 shapes
- Place 3D dots one in each corner and one in the middle for support!



Step 7:
Get another sheet of paper...
Write name on paper!
Draw what you see!
Draw with values!
