Clay, variety of ceramic tools, slip, and glaze

- Are there any patterns that interest you?
- Do you want your piece to be functional or sculptural?
- What patterns are seen that can be created with clay?
- Do you want one repeating pattern to cover the surface or multiple surface designs and textures?
- How can you achieve the decoration you want (eg. carve into piece, add clay on, stamp textures, etc)?

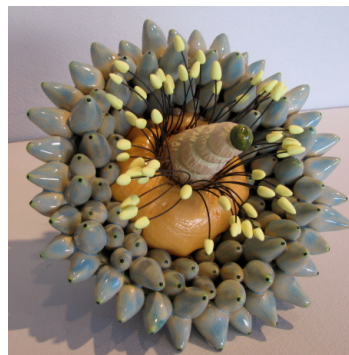
Take the time to draw some sketches in your sketchbook of the patterns that interest you and different forms that you can
